Bible Lesson

Now it's time to jump into our Bible Story for today!

First, get comfy, grab a Bible, and as a **family read Psalm 23 together**. Next, watch the video lessons, then, discuss it together using the activities below.

SNACK | Sharing Time

INSTRUCTIONS: *Pass out a snack to each kid. As the kids eat their snacks, ask them the following question about the Bible story.*

In our Bible story today, we read God prepares a table for us (Psalm 23:5). **What are your favorite foods you'd like to see on that table?**

God cares so much about us, even down to what we eat! God is always watching over us!

ACTIVITY | Circle Time

INSTRUCTIONS: *Sit the kids in a circle. Roll a small, soft ball to a kid and tell them to say: "God watches over me when I _____" (Insert something you do during the day. Examples: eat lunch, brush my teeth, go to the park, etc.). Tell them to roll the ball to another kid and repeat the process until everyone has had a turn.*

Does God always watch over you?

Is God ever not watching over you?

You can always feel safe knowing God is watching over you!

Memory Verse

Time to get God's word deep in our hearts. We believe memorizing scripture is so important to knowing his ways and having wisdom for everyday situations. Take a few minutes to go over the memory verse together!
